

GUIDE FOR EDITING DOCUMENTS NEEDED FOR A VISIT TO KENYA.

1) QR Code of the Kenyan Health Authority

- a. Register at the Kenyan Health authority under https://ears.health.go.ke/airline_registration/
- b. Fill all fields as requested
- c. After 24 hours check under the link if your QR code has been issued.
- d. Print the document and show it at check-in.

2) Visa document preparation

- a. Prepare the following documents for uploading onto your PC under the visa application page
- b. Passport size photo
- c. Photo of the outer cover of your passport
- d. Photo of an empty page in your passport
- e. Photo of the biometric data page in your passport
- f. Booking confirmation of the hotel/cottages
- g. Address of your hotel/cottages

Please note: The accepted maximum size of an image accepted on the visa application tool is 290 kb

3) Visa Application

- a. Create an account on e-citizen: <https://www.ecitizen.go.ke>
- b. Signin to your account
- c. Click on "e-visa application" on the dashboard
- d. Answer all questions on the application form and upload the files prepared on your computer.
- e. Sign-in to your account again after 24 - 48 hours to check if the visa has been issued. Print it and show it at check-in.
